It was moved by Michelle Olympiadis and seconded by Cynthia Eshè Collins to approve the FY2022 Budget with total appropriation amounts as presented: Consolidated General Fund \$904,598,784 (Nine Hundred Four Million Five Hundred Ninety-Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty-Four Dollars), Special Revenue Fund \$362,882,422 (Three Hundred Sixty-Two Million Eight Hundred Eighty-Two Thousand Four Hundred Twenty-Two Dollars), SPLOST Fund \$86,948,933 (Eighty-Six Million Nine Hundred Forty-Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty-Three Dollars), Nutrition Fund \$33,384,739 (Thirty-Three Million Three Hundred Eighty-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Thirty-Nine Dollars), and the Student Activity Fund \$4,500,000 (Four Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars). The total appropriation for all funds is \$1,392,314,878 (One Billion Three Hundred Ninety-Two Million Three Hundred Fourteen Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-Eight Dollars).
