Welcome to AP3D! In this class you will investigate the principles and elements of 3D design and sculpture while refining skills and technical aspects of creating 3 dimensional art.

Successful students:

- work many hours outside of the scheduled class time on artwork, research and investigation

- are thoughtful in the concepts behind their work
- are motivated, open to feedback, positive, and give thoughtful feedback

Course Portfolio Requirements:

- **5 Quality** pieces – *Your best work that deal with design issues in concept, form, and execution/technique*
- **8 Breadth** piece – *Work that deals with principles of design unity/variety, balance, emphasis, contrast, rhythm, repetition, proportion/scale & positive/negative space.*
- **6-12 Concentration** pieces – *a body of work that shows a thoughtful investigation of a specific visual idea – An idea, concept or theme is critical in this section. You cannot simply use one kind of material as a concentration without a strong underlying visual idea attached.*

Summer Homework – Due the first day of Class

- 1) Make a list of **at least 10** possible concentration ideas – these ideas should be based off of your personal interests. You may use internet searches for investigation, but choose ideas that you relate to. – **20 pts Formative**
- 2) Sketch **15** sculptural plans/ideas along with construction information included in the sketch (size/dimensions, materials/mediums, display (will it sit, hang on the wall, from the ceiling?)). Each sketch needs to be at least one full page in your sketchbook. These must be your own ideas. – **30 pts Formative**
- 3) Create 1 complete sculpture based on a concentration idea and sketch. – **100 pts Summative** – *You must bring this sculpture with you on the first day of class. If you are unable to obtain the materials needed for your idea, you must be creative and use ingenuity to alter your plans or idea in order to fulfill the assignment.*

Materials:

- 1) A hardbound Sketchbook 8.5" x 11" is mandatory and should be used for the summer homework. They can be purchased at Sam Flax.
- 2) Lab Fee \$20.00 - due the first week of school
- 3) Any out of the norm materials that are specific to the individual's Concentration

*All other materials will be supplied unless they are too complex for the art classroom environment.
