1. Go to: <https://aps-vpn.apsk12.org>
2. Enter your APS Username & Password

3. Select the download applicable to your operating system




4. Click Run to execute the installation program
5. Click Next




6. Click Next



7. Click Next




8. Click Close to complete the installation




To Connect to APS Network via VPN:

For Window 7:


1. On your computer: Go to “All Programs”, navigate to Palo Alto Networks (Folder), Global Protect (Sub-Folder), and click on Global Protect (Icon)
2. Enter your APS network credentials
For Portal, enter **173.242.64.2**



3. Click Continue to ignore the Certificate warning.



4. Once you are connected, you should see the status window below



5. You may close the Status window. You are now on APS network via VPN.
