How Many Points Has Your Scholar Earned?





APSprotects Student, Staff + Facility Safety



Atlanta Public Schools (APS) is constantly working proactively to keep our students and staff healthy and safe, especially in our COVID-19 environment. Here are just a few of our ongoing health and safety efforts:



AIR

- Invested \$68 million to upgrade our heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) systems
- Serviced and monitored over 20,000 pieces of HVAC equipment in schools and
- Upgrading HVAC system filters to most efficient version the system can handle
- ·Increasing pre-occupancy and post-occupancy HVAC run times from two hours to three hours



- · Continuous flushing and disinfecting of water sources in buildings (water fountains, sinks, showers, etc.)
- Proactive testing for Legionella pneumophila
- · Use of bottled water and bottle filling stations in schools

BUILDINGS + BUSES





- Use of fogging machines for commercial-grade cleaning/sanitizing of schools and buses
- Twice daily wipe downs and overnight cleaning of high touch common areas
- Use of hand sanitizing stations in common areas and
- Set building capacity levels at 60% for in-person learning to implement social distancing to the greatest extent possible
- outside organizations



- Developed a comprehensive COVID-19 testing strategy
- ·Providing personal protective equipment (PPE) for students and staff and requiring the use of PPE in schools and buildings
- · Additional screening measures and temperature checks upon entry into buildings
- Practicing social distancing and other protocols per CDC auidance
- ·Limiting class sizes and the number of people in buildings

RETURN+LEARN JANUARY 2021

What you need to know

as Atlanta Public Schools prepares for a proposed January 2021 reopening.

The reopening will maintain our three instructional models

- Virtual with Your School
- Person at Your School
- Virtual with Atlanta Virtual Academy

In-person instruction will be phased-in:

PreK-2 and Special Education (Low Incidence -PreK-12) students return February 1st Grades 3-5, 6, 9, and 10th grade students return February 4th Grades 7, 8, 11, and 12th grade students return

Beginning in November 2020, APS:

- Expanded academic interventions across all schools for the neediest students
- Offered in-person instructional support for some special education students
- Continued to monitor APS Athletics and identified potential opportunities for APS

Arts to perform/practice in-person in small groups

Beginning in December 2020, APS:

- Launched Independent Learning Days on Wednesdays in which students learn at different times of the day and work at their own pace. During this time, our teachers will have the opportunity to organize, rearrange, and prepare their rooms for the reopening of schools in January 2021
- Modified our food distribution plans to account for Independent Learning Days and
- Launched an Intent to Return Declaration Form for all students to select or change

APS Nutrition Update
