Impact of Covid on Instruction

- 29.6 % of students absent due to Covid-19 related illness or exposure
 - 254,310 minutes of lost instructional time
- 49.6 % of students absent due to reported illness
 - 205,920 minutes of lost instructional time
- 50% of staff quarantined due to Covid illness or exposure
 - 34% provide direct instruction to scholars



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Schools and educators across the country are facing some of the most significant Human Resource challenges in recent memory




Fewer undergraduates want to enter the teaching profession

Enrollment has been steadily declining for the past decade, and the pandemic has likely made things worse.

11%

20 percent of institutions reported a decline in new undergraduate enrollment of 11percent. —AACTE



Educators that are in schools are experiencing stress and isolation

Schools are understaffing — 80% of teachers report that unfilled job positions have burdened them with additional work obligations. —National Education Association Survey February 2022

More educators than ever are thinking about quitting or taking a leave of absence

Atlanta Public Schools Talent Management Strategy Update



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At APS, our teachers and leaders report similar challenges

- 64%** Increase in percentage of staff accessing mental health resources through the Employee Assistance Program website
- 32%** Increase in employees' need for financial assistance
- 71%** Substitute fill rate percentage dropped by 20 percentage points.
- 76%** Principal retention rate. It is important to note 12 of our 14 FY23 principal vacancies were due to promotional advancement.

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
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- **Nationwide Problem**

- **@BaMO roughly 86% of staff returning for 22-23 SY**
- **Reasons for Leaving**
 - **Promotions**
 - **Family Reasons (closer to home, family relocation, etc.)**
 - **Not returning to teaching**
