



- #1 growth/increase in APS (+19.3 points) for ELA proficiency from 2022 to 2024 on the GMAS (3rd-5th Grades)
- #1 growth/increase in APS (+13.3) for ELA proficiency among traditional schools from 2023-2024 on the GMAS (3rd-5th Grades)
- Highest decrease in the percentage of beginning learners for 3rd-5th grades on the GMAS in APS traditional schools from 2023-2024 in ELA and Science combined
- 2nd largest decrease among APS traditional schools of beginning learners on the ELA GMAS (3rd-5th grades) and 4th largest decrease of beginning learners on the Science GMAS from 2023 to 2024
- 70% of BaMO students had typical /high growth (SGP) on the 2024 ELA GMAS (78% in 2023 as compared to the state average of 65%)

- ADA (Average Daily Attendance) rate increased from 51.4%( 2022) to 71.9% (2024)
- 95.7 metric progress measure on the state CCRPI data profile as compared to 89.9 metric progress measure for the district and 85.8 metric progress measure for the state
- 90.9 metric closing gaps measure on the state CCRPI data profile as compared to 86.2 closing gaps measure for the district and 66.7 closing gaps measure for the state
- Over 90% retention of teachers/staff from 2023-2024 school year with 100% of all new teachers returning for 2024-2025
