 - ii. Signature Instructional Coach for the IB position This person will help to oversee the mathematics instruction in the building, in addition to the year one feasibility responsibilities of IB. They will also be responsible for the candidacy application.
 - iii. SST Coordinator to support the MTSS process for academics and behavior.
 - iv. Processing adding another Assistant Principal to support K-2 instruction. They will also support attendance during the transition to our relocation site.
 - v. Attendance Specialist to support attendance during the transition to our relocation site.
 - vi. We like to allocate funds to do an additional route for students who may have missed the bus. Working with the district to allocate funds for this additional service.
 - vii. Part time Spanish program- We are looking to move back to a part-time Spanish teacher. We will no longer be using the Fuel Education Program.
 - viii. Reserve Funds possibilities
 - 1. Professional Development
 - 2. Additional support for our Mindfulness Room
 - ix. Title 1 Holdback and Family Engagement Funds
 - 1. Provide additional transportation to-from our new site for the 2020-2021 school year.
