- h. Mr. Garner stated he is more excited about the Milestones testing as opposed to the MAP testing, the energy from students and teachers is driving in the Milestones testing.
- i. Strengths Reading Data is helping us to understand test taking strategies; increases in reading, which we know that the achievement gap is a literacy gap
- j. Opportunities -We want to see more students move from red to green – growth. More targeted instruction in math; interdisciplinary strategies will help continue steady growth; recognizing whole-child approach to learning and grouping.
- k. Achieve excellence Attendance, interdisciplinary on literacy, multi-layer learning techniques to make sure the children are learning equally, alter the teaching to engage the children.
