Strengthening the instructional core

Improving student performance on milestones (Increase the number of students that score proficient and above on 6 of 8 GA Milestones Assessments.

Increasing graduate rate.

Next time we meet, Dr. Wilson will show how she allocated funds to support the BTW will likely experience a decrease in allocations due to the decrease in enrollment, 2019-2020

What are signature funds?? Monies allotted to Washington to support STEM - - STEM materials, professional learning, field trips, salary for STEM coordinator



Meeting Minutes

Title I Holdback - this is something that is done district wide, and once numbers are settled, schools receive the holdback monies.

ALLOCATION- - CTAE, where is the CTAE Allocation falling within the Budget by Function - - In the folder, within the Budge by Function, CTAE would fall within Instruction

Nuri – is the budget at a decrease for next year?

Dr. Wilson's response:

2018-2019 -- 8 million

2019-2020 - - 7.6 million

Nuri asks, wit the decrease in budget how will that affect instruction

Wilson: the average class size for HS is 1:32 Ratio - - Until we know how many teachers we need, and have the master schedule and know what kids needs,

We will do our best not to impact school programming, anything that supports graduating in 4 years.

Nina Packer: Are there any grants? There is a GO TEAM Grant, that is open for any GO TEAM to apply for - - \$4000.00 (to support the signature program) Wilson is not sure the funding sourcing of this grant, but it is open for BTW to pitch one of its initiatives that supports are three core priorities.

APS has a separate pot of money, that is not included in school budgets - -Schools receive an allotment of money to support parent /family engagement, there is an allotment for BTW for family / parent engagement: 11,000.00

NURI: Did we have this same allocation for this school year? How was it used? How successful was this

WILSON: Yes, Teachers visiting parents at home

NURI: How many students are in STEM?





WILSON: approx. 200 – the STEM certification is based on this 200-student count.

In your budget, you have instructional staff, and non-instructional staff - - do you have a line item, for

No allocation for facilities upgrades? SPLOST, Facilities creates a schedule of priorities for each school.

Nina Packer asked, "With regard to partners, larger partners - - How is that money reflected in this allocation document?"
