C Principal's Report Review of Data Points, via PPT The school's CCRPI (54.1) is dangerously within range of being given the designation CSI (Comprehensive Support Improvement) - - like a PD Plan for schools. We need to be @ 70 CCRPI to reach to safety - - a very heavy lift, to go from 54.1 to 70 within one school year. What's more, our Special Ed student population is also not making sufficient gains which is why the school does carry the designation TSI

Strategic Plan:

IT is noted that 6A is empty. Since this component speaks to school culture, Dr. CY proposes to use the following for 6A:

Provide monthly ABC incentives to students, provide training to staff on impacting the SEL and wrap around initiative, as well as tackling student disengagement. It is also proposed that 4C is deleted, since there is not a foreseeable way to quantify this, given that the whole plan is somewhat grandfathered in, from a previous administration.

S Freeman motions to approve the plan but with the added piece that Dr. CY mentions, and removing 4C.

D Chair's Report

Successfully wrote a GO TEAM Community Engagement 76ggrant proposal (\$5000). Given that 2020 will give way to major systems being implemented (superintendent search, Facilities Master Planning, 2020 - 2025 APS Strategic Plan, Development of APS Equity Commission, among other things), the grant proposal seeks to commission a consultant to come in and to help the school analyze how the students and caregivers of the Washington Cluster benefit from the processes. From a GO TEAM perspective, how do we have effective input into these processes?
