We proceed to vote:

A question is raised by Go Team member Elicia Ellis, in reference to Ms. Packer's organization [Urban Specialists]. Ms. Ellis wishes to see data that shows the effectiveness of her organization dealing with violence in an urban community. She also asks, "What is your [Nina Packer's] motivation for wanting to be on GO TEAM?

Ms. Packer's answer to 1st question - - it is in her DNA, she is an advocate for life, for the community's young people. She cites her membership at Shiloh church, where their community outreach is embedded in the Washington Park community. She has worked with several educational boards, on the charter school side, two of which she helped to found.

Ms. Packer's answer to 2nd question: In lieu of concrete data at this meeting, Nina elaborates that, the organization, Urban Specialists was organized to address gang violence. Her organization has cited evidence in helping our seniors with SAT preparation.

Elicia Ellis: What do you hope to achieve by being a part of our GO TEAM? She hopes to help BTW achieve its goals as outlined in the BTW strategic plan, she notes that there is a disparity among schools that have few resources, and those that have lots of resources
