Public Comment

At D.M. Therrell High School, your voice matters. We encourage our community to come and spend time with us at our GO Team meetings to learn more about the governance side of D.M. Therrell, as well as share with us any concerns that you may have.

Opportunities for public comment shall be provided at least four (4) times in a school/fiscal year and noted on the meeting agenda. Those dates are:

- December 9th, 2020
- February 10th, 2021
- March 10, 2021
- April 14th, 2021

Public comment opportunities are available for GO Teams to hear from interested members of the community. GO Team members will not provide responses or engage in direct conversation during meetings. Each GO Team may determine a consistent method for receiving public comments and for parents and other citizens to sign up to address the team, provided that the team offer at least 20 minutes of time to the public to make comments, when available, and that the public receive at least 2 business days' notice of the protocol for signing up to speak.

The D.M. Therrell GO Team hereby provides notice of its Public Comment protocol.

The D.M. Therrell Team welcomes and encourages citizens to attend its meetings to become better acquainted with the programs of D.M. Therell and the role of the GO Team. Unless otherwise provided by law, the GO Team meetings are open to the public. Citizens are welcome to attend the meetings but must refrain from interrupting or distracting the GO Team proceedings.

For those people wishing to provide comment, designated time periods for public comment are identified on each agenda. Public comment is planned as an official agenda for 4 out of the 6 official meetings of the Therrell GO Team. Please refer to each published agenda to confirm the time periods. Public Comment opportunities are contingent upon all agenda items being discussed first, but it is our goal to schedule public comment time as close to 4:30 pm – 5:00 pm as possible.

During the COVID period, click on the Zoom link which is on the agenda. Each member of the public will have two (2) minutes to speak. At the end of each public comment period, the period will be closed and the GO Team will move on to the next agenda item. If there are questions or information that you have for the GO Team, you may also contact one or more of the GO Team members before or after the meetings.
