




# Next Steps

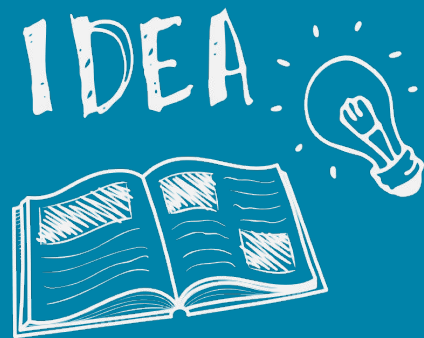
