Public Comment Protocol

The GO Team at L.J. Price Middle School invites all community members to attend our upcoming meetings. These meetings offer an opportunity to learn more about the school's academic and extracurricular programs, as well as the important role the GO Team plays in shaping school policies and initiatives.

Meeting Access and Participation Guidelines:

GO Team meetings are open to the public, and all community members are welcome to attend. Please note that while attendees may observe the proceedings, interruptions are not permitted. However, there is a designated time for public comments. The process is outlined below:

Public Comment Protocol:

- **Sign-Up Deadline:** All speakers must sign up at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the meeting.
- **How to Sign Up:** Email the GO Team Chair and copy the school principal. Include a brief summary of the topic you wish to address. Contact information for both can be found on the GO Team homepage.
- **Speaking Time:** Each speaker is allotted up to 2 minutes. A timer will be used. Up to 10 speaker slots are available per meeting when public comment is on the agenda.
