#### **Action Items**

Agenda - Rebecca Blanchette motioned to approve the agenda. Ellie Boydston seconded the motion. All members of the GO Team voted in favor.

Minutes from February 24<sup>th</sup> Meeting - Katy and Emily made an addition to the minutes, which will be updated. Rebecca Blanchette motioned to approve the minutes with the change. Chris Pirouz seconded the motion. All members of the GO Team voted in favor.

**Budget Approval Presentation** 

- The budget presentation is the same as the 2/24 meeting. The positions at Sarah Smith break out as follows:
  - $\circ$  7 classroom teachers in K-4; 6 classroom teachers for 5<sup>th</sup> grade
  - 4.5 ESOL teachers
  - 6 Special Education teachers
  - o 3 Gifted teachers
  - 2 teachers each in Art, Music, and PE
  - 3 French teachers total 2 FT, 2PT
  - $\circ$  Media Specialist is being reduced to one with one Paraprofessional
  - o 1 Counselor
  - 1 PT tutor working on skills deficit
  - **1 EIP**
  - Nurses are paid hourly
  - Reducing all K Paraprofessionals (paras) from FT to PT (7 positions) concern over this and that we would lose these paras because of no benefits and reduced pay. Emily



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looked at a school that did this in the past, and paras were pretty stable even after this change.

- Admin and staff stays the same
- Questions from the team:
  - Are there any opportunities to get more money in budget? The only place Emily sees additional funds would be because we are getting the Autism Support Unit that is currently at E Rivers is coming here. We will get additional students as a result of this. Not sure about the staffing for this and if the teacher is coming.
  - One media specialist and para what does this look like? We will pull media and counselor out of specials rotation (which the teachers want because it eliminates doubles). One campus for one week, and then flip. Para pro would be assistant - not the media specialist job responsibilities.
- Jennifer Sand motioned to approve budget. Chris Pirouz seconded. All members voted in favor

Katy wanted to share something to be aware of - Senate Bill 386 - This is the bill that helps kids with disabilities. Takes money they get at public school and applies it for them to use at private school. The new bill would allow students with 504 to be considered for this money. If this passes, it would drive coast up to \$40-90 million. Not a good idea because it is taking funding away from public schools. The way it is being implemented, is this really helping the kids and helping their special needs?

Family Engagement and Communications Advisory Committee Goals and Objectives - will delay approval until next meeting. Katy will share these through email and then we will approve at next meeting.

## **Discussion Items -**

Update on GO Team Candidates

- Voting will be in mid April.
- Once we get final list of names from the GO Team office, we will invite parents to PTO meeting on April 15<sup>th</sup> so that they can introduce themselves. Faculty meeting is on April 14<sup>th</sup>. We usually post something in teacher room about the candidates and the voting.
