New Family Information Handbook



Welcome new Parkside students, parents, caregivers and families! We are so glad you're here!

As a new family to Parkside, it can be a challenge to navigate all the different school programs, events and activities. This guide is intended to make the transition to the Parkside community a little easier.

Start of the School Year

- First day of school for the 2023-2023 school year is Tuesday August 1, 2023. The 2022-2023 calendar can be located here - www.atlantapublicschools.us/Page/49782
- Open House for the 2023-2024 school year will be July 31st 9:00-11:00 where you can visit the classroom. You will get an email before Open House with your child's teacher.

- Set up an account for lunch at <https://www.myschoolbucks.com>. You'll need your child's ID number, which can be found by calling the front office.



School Day

- School hours are 7:45am - 2:45pm.
- Students can be dropped off between 7:15 am - 7:45 am. After 7:45 am, students are considered tardy and will need to be signed in at the front desk.



Bus Drop Off



- All students living more than one mile from the school are eligible to take the bus. Information on bus routes will be distributed at the Open House just before the school year begins, and route information can be found on the APS website (www.atlantapublicschools.us/domain/5364).
- Students get off the bus in lane in front of the school and are not released until 7:15 am.
- Kindergarteners and Pre-K typically sit in the front of the bus, closest to the driver.

Car Rider Drop Off



- Drop off is in the carpool lane in front of the school doors.
- Car line forms from Waldo, down to Mercer.
- Students can be dropped off anytime between 7:15 - 7:45 am.
- Staff will be there to assist with doors.
- Please do not drop your student off prior to 7:15 as there is no one available to monitor your student before the doors open for the day.

*Pre-K students should always be walked to the classroom via the Pre-K entrance unless they take the bus. Pre-K parents can park in the lot next to the playground or along Mercer to walk their student to the door.



Late Drop Off or Early Pick Up

- Front doors are closed and locked during the school day. Please ring the bell at the front to be buzzed in.
- Students dropped off after 7:50 am need to be walked in to the front office and signed in.
- Students who arrive at school prior to 11 am will be considered as present, just tardy.
- Students who leave after 11 am will be considered present for the day.
- Latest pick up for the day, prior to regular dismissal, is 2:15 pm. No students will be permitted to be signed out after 2:15 pm.

Attendance

Absence Line: 404-802-4100



Your child's attendance at school is crucial to their success. Research indicates that students who miss 8 or more days of school (including excused and unexcused absences) are more likely to be academically at risk. Thank you for viewing school as a priority, and seeing that your child attends everyday with the exception of illness or emergency.

If your child will be absent from school, please call or email the absence line EACH day they will be out.

Excused Absences: Illnesses are excused if they are called in to the attendance line.

Unexcused Absences: If you do not notify the attendance line of an absence, it will be unexcused.

- 3 unexcused absences - A letter is mailed home with attendance expectations.
- 5 unexcused absences - A letter is mailed home with information regarding possible consequences.
- 8 unexcused absences - Student may be referred to school social worker.
- 10 unexcused absences - Additional intervention occurs and social worker may refer student to Juvenile Court.

After School Dismissal

- At Open House or on the first day of school, you'll be asked to notify the school of your student's typical after-school transportation method or after-school program.
- On any day that you will not be following the plan you provided, you must let your child's teacher know in writing or call the main office (404-802-4100).
- No dismissal changes can be made after 2 pm.
- To ensure last minute changes are received, it is best to call the main office and speak with someone. Emails to teachers may not always be read in time.



Dismissal Procedures



Bus Riders:

- Bus riders are dismissed at 2:45 pm and buses typically leave the school by 2:50 pm.
- Parkside staff will walk students to their bus.
- Buses pick up in front of the school doors, in the carpool lane.

Car Riders:

- Car riders are picked up between 2:50 - 3:00 pm at the gym doors.
- Caregivers/adults are not permitted to park and walk up to the gym door.
- Please enter the line by coming south on Eloise, take a right on Mercer, and then enter the gym parking lot as shown on the maps on the next page.
- Pickup tags will be provided at the start of the school year.

Parent Pick Up:

- Located at the side doors near the playground and cafeteria.
- For families who would like to park and walk up to the school to pick up their students.
- Park on Mercer (closer to Waldo and the playground) and walk down to the end of the parking lot, near the map painting.
- Do not exit area towards car rider line. (See map on next page.)

Walkers:

- Independent walkers who do not need a parent present for pick are dismissed after buses have left and before car riders are dismissed.
- Students will be escorted to end of school grounds with staff member.

Pre-K students:

- Unless they ride a bus, all pre-k students should be picked up from the pre-k hallway in front of the school.
- Parents can park on Mercer and walk down to greet their students.

All students not participating in afterschool programs should be picked up no later than 3:15 pm.





After-School Program:

- The on-site after school program is administered by Preferred School Care (<https://psafterschool.ce.eleyo.com/>). You can register your student in the program now or at Open House. Care is provided from 2:45 to 6:00 p.m.
- Afterschool enrichment classes/clubs (ballet, yoga, soccer, etc.) are also offered for an additional fee. They usually start about a month into the semester; details will be sent home with the students after the school year begins.

Meals

Breakfast	Lunch	Beverages & Snacks

Reduced lunch is \$.30.● Students will have the option to eat breakfast when they arrive at school, starting at 7:15 am.● If your student will be eating, please ensure they arrive with enough time to finish.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● In 2023-24, lunch is \$3.00. Reduced lunch costs \$.40.● Please make sure your child can open all parts of their home lunch without help.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● All students should bring a water bottle to school. Please label the bottle with your child's name. There are hydration stations available to refill it at the school.● Snacks might be individual or coordinated by the teacher. Stay tuned.

Parkside has nut-free classes, so please check with your teacher. Don't send peanut butter, nuts, or any items containing tree nuts if your child's class is nut-free.



Uniforms

All Parkside students (including pre-K students) should wear the Parkside uniform Monday through Thursday. The uniform is a collared shirt (polo or button-down), in dark blue/navy, dark green/forest, or white, along with shorts, pants, skirts, or jumpers in khaki or dark blue/navy. Dark blue/navy or dark green/forest polo dresses may also be worn.

Students have PE one day per week and recess outside every day, so we recommend shoes that are comfortable and safe for play. Please no sandals or flip-flops – or they'll be asked to sit out during PE.

Friday is a uniform-free day! But students should adhere to the APS dress code (found in the APS policy handbook that will go home in the coming days). Examples: no short shorts, midriff shirts, etc.

Communication

The school communicates important information to parents via the Remind system, phone calls, text messages, daily homework folders, and the Green Folder, which goes home with students every Thursday. Talk to your student's teacher to find out the best way to communicate directly with them when needed.

Lost and Found

Lost and found is located inside of the gym doors, to the left. Please ask students to be mindful and remember to bring home what they brought to school on a daily basis.

Emergency Drills

Parkside Elementary and Atlanta Public Schools are required to complete school emergency drills regularly throughout the school year.

Due to safety concerns, dates and times of emergency drills will not be published. Please contact your child's teacher or Counselor Brown if you are concerned about the impact of these drills on your child.

Drills will include:

- Fire drills
- Tornado drills
- Earthquake drills
- Lockdown drills
- Shelter-in-place
- Bomb threats
- Reverse evacuation drills

Recess

Students have 30 minutes of recess time. If the weather is not cooperating (ex. heavy rain), students will still have "indoor recess."


Pre-K

Pre-K students follow the same schedule and general policies as the rest of the school. They do not go to PE or other special classes, but they do have lunch and recess every day. Pre-K students have a rest period and an afternoon snack each day. Your teacher may ask you to send in a change of clothing for emergencies and a blanket for naps.

Kindergarten

Kindergarten students do not have a nap or rest time. Teachers provide plenty of "brain breaks" and opportunities to get their "wiggles out."
