Q. Do you qualify for Childcare and Parents Service Program (CAPS) assistance for ASP?

A. Parents or guardians who have a limited income and who are also working, attending school, or are in job training may qualify for subsidizing childcare.

Q. Where do you apply for childcare assistance?

A. CAPS will determine your eligibility. If you are interested in applying, submit an application online at www.compass.ga.gov. You can also visit your local DFACS office or call 1-877-423-4746. *Once you have been approved, PSC will provide you with the quote sheet with our provider ID to complete the process.
