Pandemic Response Team

Since the onset of COVID-19, a group of Parkside parents have been working with Ms. Green and other Parkside staff to make sure that all of our Parkside families get the support they need during this difficult time. Through an incredible shared effort, we have accomplished the following together:

- 168 people have donated to the fund to support basic needs if you haven't donated yet, here's the link! (tinyurl.com/Parksidefund)
- Over 200 families have either given or received resources: food, clothing, cleaning supplies and other basic needs.
- We have gotten nearly a dozen families connected to the internet so they can participate in our learning options and we're on track to connect even more.
- We're connecting with our neighbors in TrestleTree and folks from the Housing Justice League to work together to support stable and sustainable housing for Parkside families
- We have connected with the APS Nutrition, Early Learning and Partnerships departments to share some of our feedback about things we've learned. We hope that these insights can support broader systemic changes that will support greater equity.
