PARKSIDE WINS BIG IN DONATIONS & GRANT FUNDING

DonorsChoose.org: OshKosh/Carters sponsored all 18 projects Parkside educators posted in November and December. Plus, they donated an additional \$10,000, which was split among educators for extra supplies (around \$200 each). Supplies ranged from books and STEM kits to technology and a t-shirt press.

Local donations: New Grant Park restaurant, Your Pie, hosted a soft opening, donating all proceeds to Parkside, ANCS and Wesley. Each school received \$1,240, and an anonymous donor matched the donations for a total of \$2,480 coming to us.

Grants: Parkside has won four grants: CREATE, a teacher residency program; REAP (Reading is Essential for All People) and Everybody Wins! Atlanta, both of which focus on improving reading proficiency; and the Atlanta Local Food Initiative Orchard Grant, which will allow us to expand our orchard this semester.
