Empire Boulevard Tactical Walk/Bike Lane

Project Description

The City of Atlanta's Department of Transportation (ATLDOT) is awarded funding through the National Center for Safe Routes to School to install a tactical walk/bike lane along Empire Boulevard, between Oak Drive and Ward Drive. This project is part of the department's Safe Routes to School program near Crawford Long Middle School and the Glenrose Heights Community. The goal is to improve safety for pedestrians and bicyclists and calm traffic on Empire Boulevard. ATLDOT anticipates installing the tactical walk/bike lane in March 2023.

Location

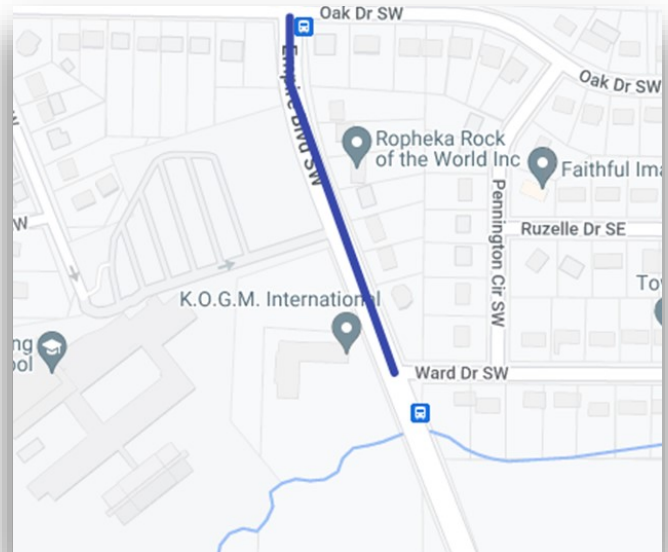
Empire Boulevard between Oak Drive and Ward Drive
