Crawford Long will take the following measures to promote and support parents as an important foundation of the school in order to strengthen the school and reach our school goals.

### We will:

- Ensure that information related to the school and parent programs, meetings, and other activities, is available in a family friendly language and published in both English and Spanish for all families.
