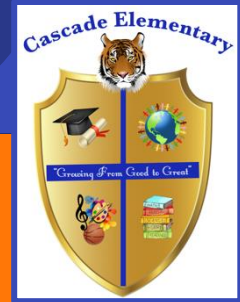

MAP Assessment Update

The data is in, and it shows that Cascade Elementary School has increased the number of proficient students in Reading and Math on the MAP Growth Assessment and have decreased the number of students performing below grade level for this academic school year. The instructional team at Cascade Elementary School has done a stellar job with teaching and learning this school year and I am so proud of them. We know that we would not be a stellar team without stellar parents. The parents have also made a huge impact by being supportive and partners in this work. In a few weeks, our 3rd – 5th grade scholars will embark on the GA Milestones Assessment. MAP performance is an indication of how well our students will perform on the GA Milestones. We will continue to intervene in the coming weeks to further prepare our scholars for grade level readiness and mastery, and we kindly ask that you do the same at home. Teaching and learning is not over for the year, but our MAP data is an indication that we will finish strong in the Tiger's Den.
