





THE BOOKER T. WASHINGTON HIGH SCHOOL **CLASS OF 1944**

In October of 1973, Charlie White approached Valgene Winfrey Jackson and expressed a desire to organize the class and plan for a Thirty Year Class Reunion. Calls were made, and the first meeting was held in November of 1973 at the Booker T. Washington High School. It was a dream come true for Charlie White when several classmates responded to the notice they received. At the second meeting on December 9, 1973 the attendance increased and the following officers were elected:

Plans began immediately for our first Reunion. In establishing an ongoing purpose for the organization, the members expressed a desire to help deserving students go on to college. With the help of former teachers, counselors, and an ad-hoc committee from the organization, students were sought out and asked to submit an essay on "Why I Would Like A Scholarship." An essay written by Perry Pettigrew was judged the winner, and he elected to attend Georgia Tech. Perry made the Deans List throughout his matriculation. Members of the Class of '44 attended his graduation. All were pleasantly surprised when the Pettigrew family presented a plaque to the Class of '44, in appreciation of our support. The Plaque was presented at a reception for Perry following his graduation.

The Class of '44 is a caring, sharing and loving group. We contribute annually to the United Negro College Fund, the NAACP, and each summer we give financial aid in sending underprivileged boys to Summer Enrichment Camp, where our classmate, Irvin Harris is the Director. We have given, on several occasions, to the Boys and Girls Club of Metro Atlanta. At the request of our Classmate, Bishop Nathaniel Linsey, who is on assignment in West Africa, we have given financial aid to an African student attending Seminary in Nigeria. For several years we gave deserving students assistance in purchasing books as they entered college. We have also supported the Band Boosters Club in purchasing new instruments for the students.

The Class of '44 worked diligently with the Class of '39 to erect the C. L. Harper Memorial. Our class was one of the first to pledge and pay \$1,000 towards the cost of the memorial; and our name is engraved on the Monument, located in the park fronting the E. R. Carter School on Ashby Street.

In November 1980, there was an occasion to help a destitute mother of five who had lost a three year old child in a day care center explosion. A local church paid the funeral expenses for the infant. Our classmate, Nellie Convers, suggested adopting this family for Christmas, and the class responded in a very positive way.

In May 1982, the class traveled to Detroit, Michigan for a most enjoyable weekend with our classmates there and those who came from Chicago to join us. In order to assist with our expenses, a fund raiser, Oldie Goldie, is held each year. We have enjoyed a weekend at Myrtle Beach; and for several years we have spent weekends at the Pine Mountain Chalets in Pine Mountain, Georgia. It was on these retreats where we discovered the talents that existed in our group. We discovered dancers, comedians, singers, gourmet cooks, and the list goes on. We culminate each year with an elegant and festive Christmas Dinner Dance.

Since our organization in 1973, we have had four dedicated presidents, namely: Robert Swain, Edward Hunt, Valgene Winfrey Jackson, and our current president Charlie White. Our 1994 officers are:
