MEANING OF SABER DAY

Saber Day is, by tradition, the day on which cadet officers of the Atlanta Public Schools' Junior Reserve Officer's Training Corps (JROTC) units are commissioned.

Although the exact origin of the term "Saber Day" is not known it is generally believed that the custom began in the days of ancient Sparta, before Christ. The day marked the young Spartan's entry into military service, and it carried with it the assumption of the duties of adulthood.
