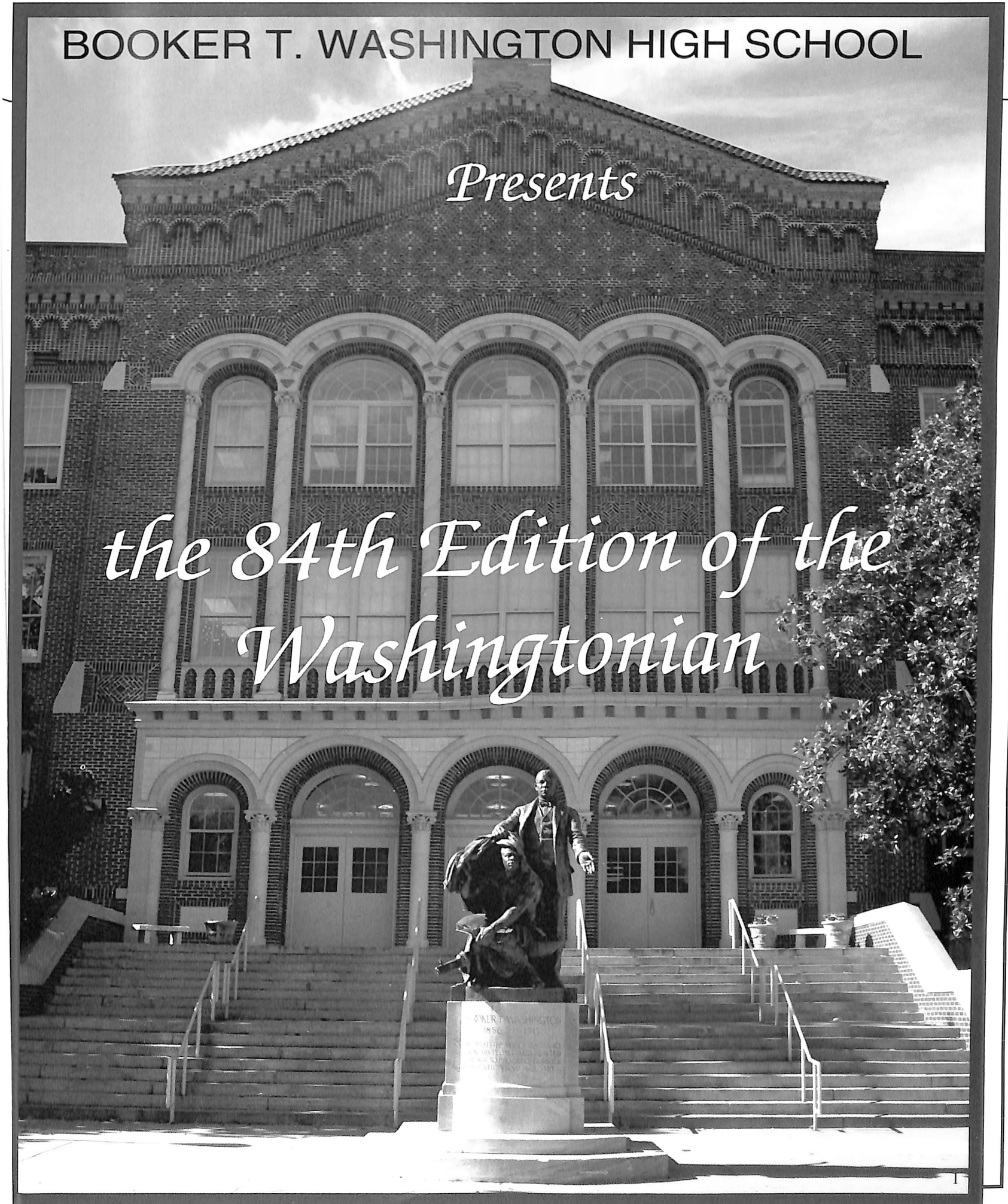

Booker T. Washington HIGH SCHOOL



Our School. . .

Booker T. Washington High School, named for the famous educator, opened in September 1924 as Georgia's first high school for African-Americans under the auspices of the Atlanta Board of Education. As the first public high school for African-Americans in the state of Georgia and the Atlanta Public Schools, Washington High School serves as a beacon in history. One of the foremost black educators of the late 19th and early 20th centuries, Booker T. Washington was born into slavery in 1856 on a small farm in Virginia. He went on to found Tuskegee Institute in 1881.

In 1927, the only exact replica of the Booker T. Washington monument at Tuskegee University in Alabama was erected at the school's entrance. The statue of Washington, called "Booker T. Washington Lifting the Veil of Ignorance," is an exact replica of the original bronze at the Tuskegee Institute by sculptor Charles Keck. The inscription reads: He lifted the veil of ignorance from his people and pointed the way to progress through education and industry.

Today, the school, which was placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1986, boasts an enrollment of more than 1500 students with a faculty and staff of more than 100.

In Remembrance of Mr. Charles K. Hodge

Mr. Charles K. Hodge, a dedicated educator, for over 36 years, touched the lives of countless students. he began his service as an educator at David T. Howard and North Fulton High Schools, teaching social studies and special education. He then became the Community School Administrator at S.H. Archer High School and Booker T. Washington High School. He later served as an Assistant Principal at Booker T. Washington High School. He was passionate that all students deserved a quality education; therefore he remained vigilant for those students who others considered unreachable. He was a mentor to many teachers, and was loved and respected by all.

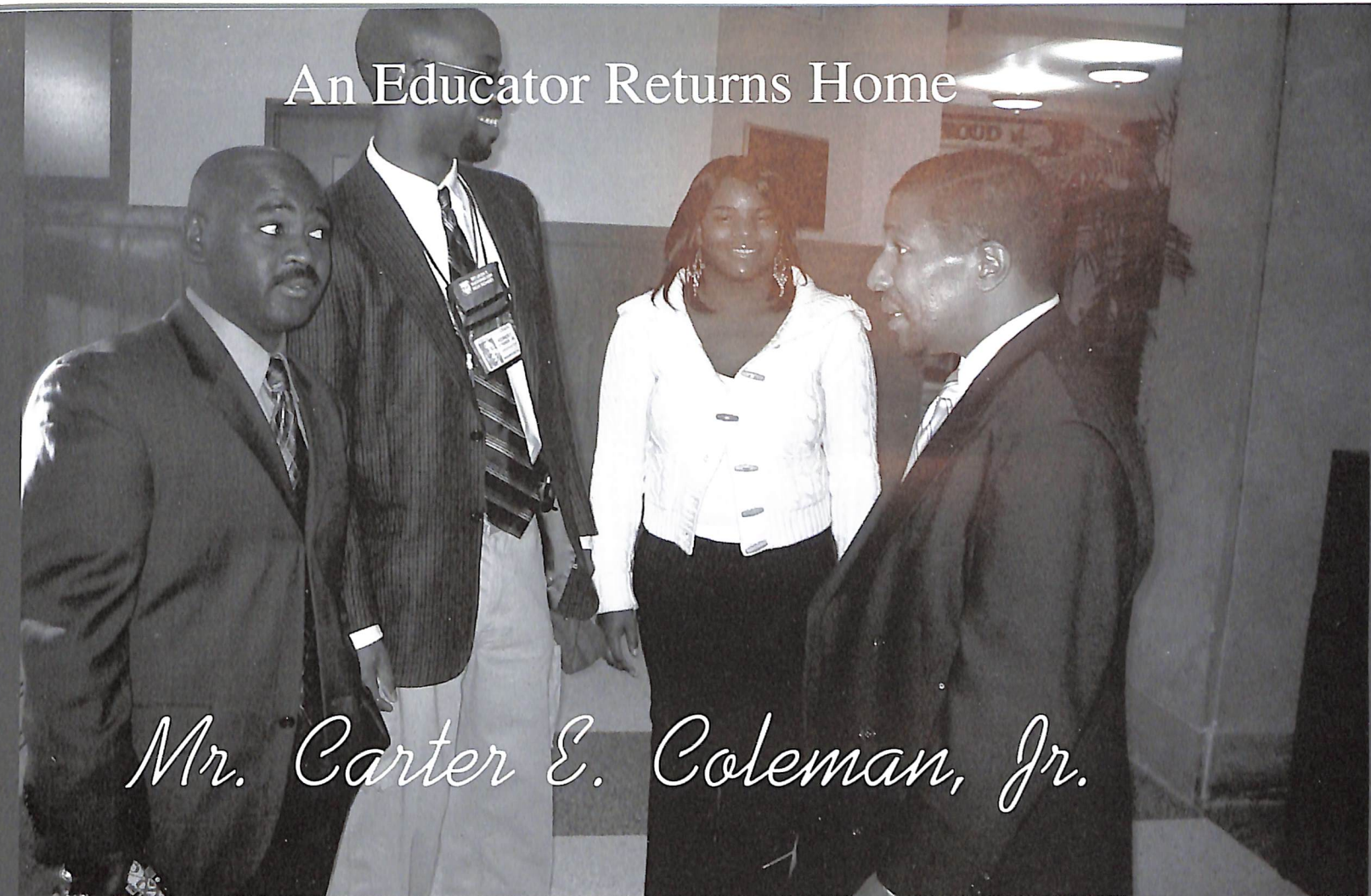
PROJECT GRAD

Teacher of the Year

My decision to become a teacher had as much to do with my experiences growing up as it had to do with the foundation that had been laid before my birth. At that time, Atlanta, my hometown was still ripe with the excitement and possibility of the Civil Rights Movement. Even the conversation among playmates resonated with language of opportunity and possibility. As children, we were taught in our homes, schools and churches that preparation was the key and the best way to prepare was to get an education. Our people before us had paved the way, and we had to be ready to inherit our legacy: the right to dream in color if we wanted and to expect that we would some day grow up and live our dreams.

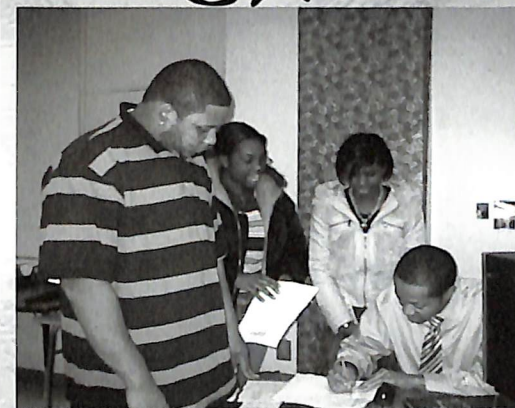
Education as a theme was interwoven throughout my childhood experiences. My maternal grandparents worked in the Atlanta Public Schools System. Ruby L. Jackson worked for a brief period as a substitute teacher, and Bruce Jackson worked as a custodian for more than 30 years. Both also worked as custodians at Georgia Baptist Hospital to support their family of 5 children. While their own educational experiences were limited, they had instilled a profound almost sacred -- sense of importance to the process of education. Our home-filled with extended family was my first school. What I learned there about life, love, leadership, and work established a foundation that has made every other accomplishment in my life possible.

My enrollment at Booker T. Washington High School was yet another part of a legacy since my parents, aunts, uncle, and paternal grandmother had graduated from the school many years before. It was there that I met Ms. Irene Bowden. Mrs. Bowden, an accomplished mathematics teacher, who recognized my positive interaction with students during group discussions, my willingness to explain problems to the class and help other classmates, was my greatest influence. She told me that I was going to be a mathematics teacher. Ms. Bowden offered enrichment activities designed to prepare me for the teaching profession. One project included developing a lesson plan with activities and methods of assessment. With the help of a nurturing family, strong and dedicated teachers, and a commitment excellence, I became the co-valedictorian of the 1987 graduating class of Booker T. Washington High School. After receiving a BBA in Management Science and Information Technology and a Master in Mathematics from the University of Georgia, it is no wonder I returned to my alma mater, Booker T. Washington High, to complete my student teaching under the guidance of Ms. Irene Bowden, and subsequently became a mathematics teacher at this historic institution. I believe that whom you inspire is more significant than whom you impress. Based on this assertion, my greatest accomplishment in education is being selected as STAR Teacher by two students during two separate times. This selection, made by the student who achieves the highest score in his school on the Scholastic Aptitude Test, is indicative of the classroom teacher who has made the greatest contribution to that students academic development.

The school year began as it often does. I am faced with a large group of students who do not believe that they have the requisite skills to succeed in mathematics. While its not an unusual challenge, it is a significant one because such fears sabotage students success. I have to shift gears. I am driven not only to teach mathematics but also to help my students enlarge their vision and develop a healthy self-image. My focus is to change their beliefs to an emphasis on effort and its relationship to achievement and to
