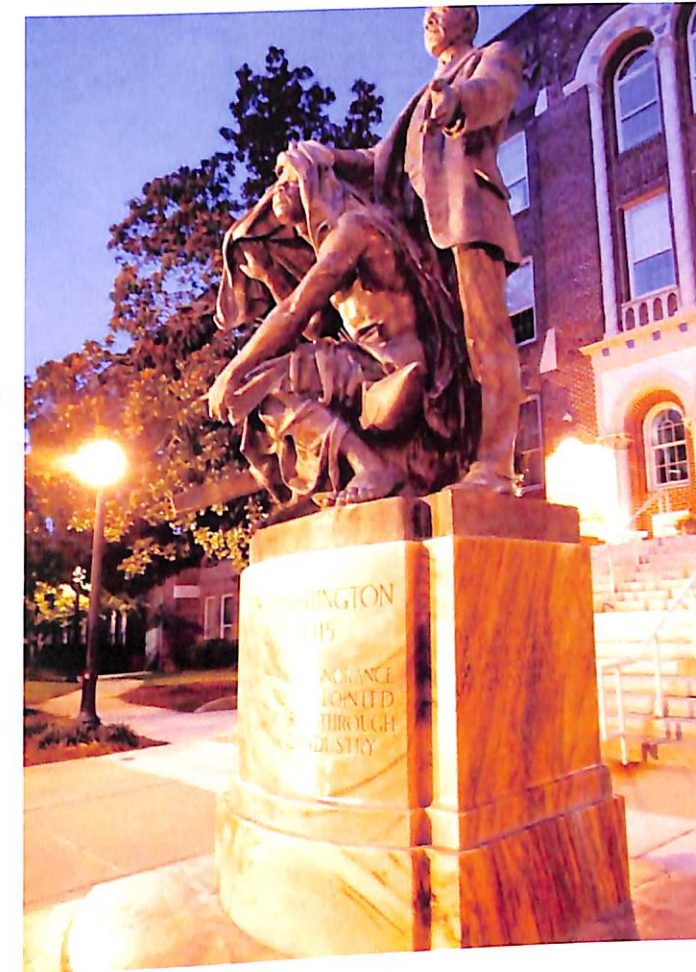

## Booker T. Washington High School History

*Booker T. Washington High School, named for the famous educator, and built because there was no secondary education available to blacks in the city of Atlanta, began operation in 1924. In 1925, the only exact replica of the Booker T. Washington monument at Tuskegee, Alabama was erected at the school's entrance.*

*We hold to this: to make provision for every pupil, regardless of economic, cultural, intellectual or physical qualifications, to grow to his highest capacity mentally , morally, and physically. We believe that this purpose can best be served for this community today through the following goals: academic instruction, vocational preparation, preparation for advanced training, and personal development.*

*In addition, we believe that of highest priority should be training of students who are capable of effecting social change and who are prepared to take advantage of the new opportunities resulting from that change.*

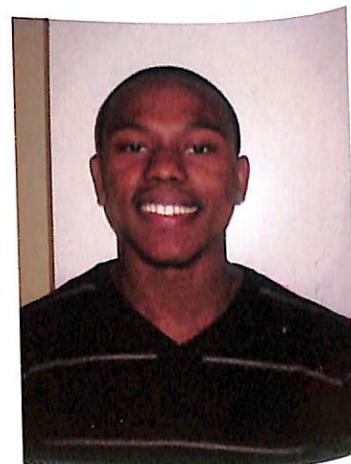


## Class of 2011 S.T.A.R. Student
