Our Origins of Tradition

African Americans, Booker T. Washington High School continues
to serve as a landmark in history.

Throughouf its years, Booker T. Washington has educated many historical figures such as Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., Leroy Johnson, Lena Horne, Nathaniel Bronner, and Louis Sullivan. All of these iconic legends have graduated and gone on to become very important figures that many idolize.

Small School History

The implementation of small schools at Booker T. Washington High School began August 2009. They were implemented to improve the graduation rate of 90 percent within four years; ensure that APS graduates are ready for college and post-secondary opportunities; make APS the first choice among students and parents in Atlanta; and provide learners with a world-class education. Now, in 2013, the first graduating class under the small school concept will have students attending college, joining the military, or entering the world of work in the fall as they fulfill their destiny to be the best!

















A Message From Doc
