# Admissions Requirements

## Classification

Sophomore (10<sup>th</sup> grader)

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## 3.0 Core GPA

2 Units of English, Math, Science  
and 1 Unit of Social Science

Completion of Algebra II required to enroll in College Algebra

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## SAT

1200 Total

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## ACT

26 Composite

- 10<sup>th</sup> graders must score a 1200 SAT total or 26 Composite on the ACT for acceptance
- 10<sup>th</sup> graders are not eligible to submit Accuplacer or PSAT for acceptance

# Dual Enrollment Funding

- Dual Enrollment Funding cap is 30 Semester credit hours
- Funding pays 100% of a student's tuition, student fees, and required book rental
- Funding only covers approved courses
  - Core academic areas (English, Math, Science, Social Science, and World Languages)
  - Career, Technical, and Agricultural (CTAE) Courses
  - Fine Arts, Physical Education, and Health not eligible for Funding
- No funding rewarded for the same course taken twice
- Students are ineligible for DE funding after their 2nd course withdrawal

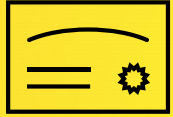




# Dual Enrollment Funding

What will be your funding responsibility?

- Course lab fees
- Proctored exams for online classes ( \$8-30 per test)
- Scantrons
- Non-funded courses & Self-pay courses
  - Responsible for tuition, student fees, and books
- Parking (if you are attending F2F Classes)
- Housing and Meal Plans (optional)

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## CHECKLIST FOR ADMITTED DUAL ENROLLMENT STUDENTS

**CONGRATULATIONS ON YOUR ACCEPTANCE TO THE DUAL ENROLLMENT PROGRAM (DEP)**  
Follow these steps to ensure you are ready for the first day of class.

### ☐ STEP 1: GET CONNECTED TO KSU

#### ☐ SET UP YOUR NET ID

- You need your Net ID to access your Owl Express, KSU email and D2L.
- Set up your Net ID by completing the form online at [netidlookup.kennesaw.edu/lookup](https://netidlookup.kennesaw.edu/lookup).

#### ☐ KSU EMAIL

- Your campus email is the primary way the Dual Enrollment Program will communicate with you.
- For the first-time setup visit [uts.kennesaw.edu/ksuemail](https://uts.kennesaw.edu/ksuemail).
- Existing users can check their email by visiting [kennesaw.edu/myksu](https://kennesaw.edu/myksu).
- Learn how to forward your KSU email to your personal email inbox by following the steps listed at [bit.ly/email-forward](https://bit.ly/email-forward).

#### ☐ SET UP DUO AUTHENTICATION

- Setting up Duo Authentication is required to log into your Owl Express, KSU email and D2L.
- Go to [kennesaw.edu/myksu](https://kennesaw.edu/myksu), scroll to the Student Services section and select Duo. Follow the steps listed for setting up the software.

### ☐ STEP 2: DUAL ENROLLMENT FUNDING APPLICATION

- Complete your funding application through [CAFutures.org](https://cafutures.org) before attending the Dual Enrollment New Student Welcome Session.
- To complete the application, sign in to your CAFutures account, choose My Dual Enrollment Profile and click on Apply Now.
- Note: As a DEP student, you are not eligible for other forms of student financial aid while a DEP student. The Dual Enrollment funding cap is 30 semester or 45 quarter hours.

### ☐ STEP 3: LAWFUL PRESENCE VERIFICATION

You can submit your lawful presence verification documents in-person or online by following the steps found at [lvp.kennesaw.edu](https://lvp.kennesaw.edu).

### ☐ STEP 4: IMMUNIZATION RECORDS

Complete your immunization records from CRITS (Georgia Immunization Registry).

- KSU will access your immunization records are not in the CRITS system, a hold will be placed on your account. You can view the hold in Owl Express and you will need to submit documentation via email ([immunizationssvc@kennesaw.edu](mailto:immunizationssvc@kennesaw.edu)) or in-person to the Registrar's Office. For information, visit [immunizations.kennesaw.edu](https://immunizations.kennesaw.edu).
- If required immunization records are not in the CRITS system, a hold will be placed on your account. You can view the hold in Owl Express and you will need to submit documentation via email ([immunizationssvc@kennesaw.edu](mailto:immunizationssvc@kennesaw.edu)) or in-person to the Registrar's Office. For information, visit [immunizations.kennesaw.edu](https://immunizations.kennesaw.edu).

### ☐ STEP 5: DUAL ENROLLMENT NEW STUDENT WELCOME SESSION

### ☐ STEP 6: D2L COLLEGE 101 AND ADVISING

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# Reminders

- ✓ Meet with your high school counselor to determine your DE classes
- ✓ Submit your funding application before applying to your DE College of Choice
  - ✓ **Your funding application is not the same as your DE College admission application**
- ✓ A GPA lower than a 2.0 is an automatic dismissal from KSU's DE program
- ✓ Use your campus resources for tutoring if you are falling behind in classes
- ✓ If you are a male turning 18 during your time as a DE student, you must complete selective service
