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IV. Discussion Items

- a. **Discussion Item 1**: 2023 Spring MAP data points- Per our school improvement plan goals, data shows that 6th and 7th grade are on track. 8th grade off by a 2% margin with reading. The numbers are our Georgia Milestone predictors and targets specific content areas. Highlight SWD, numbers speak to percentage of students hitting their goals overall 63% met the goal. Math data shows 6th grade on track. 7th and 8th grade is still a work in progress.
- b. **Discussion Item 2**: Universal Screener is given three times a year. Data shows evidence of some growth.
- c. **Discussion Item 3:** Complete needs assessment activity. Respond to guiding questions below:
 - 1) What does the data tell us?
 - We are moving in the right direction.
 - Ask students, where do you think you fall short?
 - There is a decrease from Fall to Winter...
 - Compare data from first and second test administrations.
 - Continue with data talks.
 - Review of tools needed for students to perform at their best
 - Do we need more resources to support? (before/after school programs, mental break rooms, healthy food options to feed the brain, etc.)
 - What is 6th grade doing that 7th grade is not doing? Grade level comparison-what is working vs what is not
 - Are the students really grasping the concepts?
 - 2x week, bubble students can be pulled during connections to meet with reading/math specialists. Those students who have been identified as needing additional support.
 - 2) What good news is there to celebrate?
 - 6th grade still meeting their target
 - Incredible job to teachers
 - We have done more with less
 - Numbers have grown since 2022
 - Raise the bar (expectations)
 - Excited about having staff in place to take us to the next level
 - 3) Where are growth opportunities?
 - Add additional time to focus on Reading and Math
 - 4) What trends do we see in the data?
 - Data speaks to the work being done.
