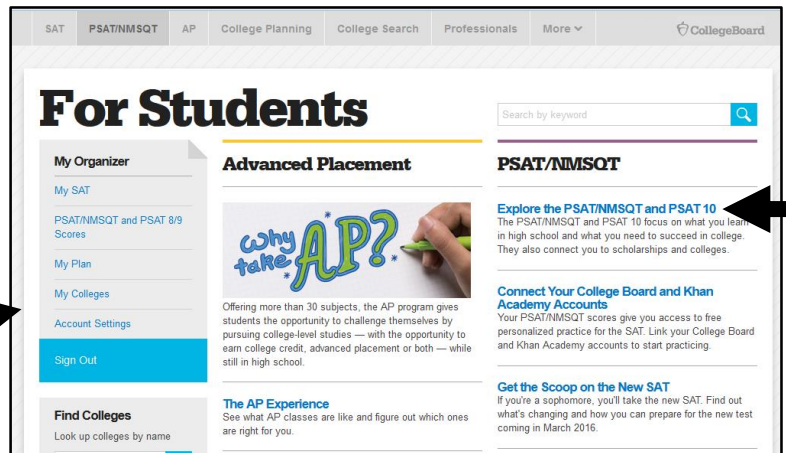


Sophomore Step-by-Step Guide to Creating & Accessing Your Personalized College Board & Khan Academy Accounts

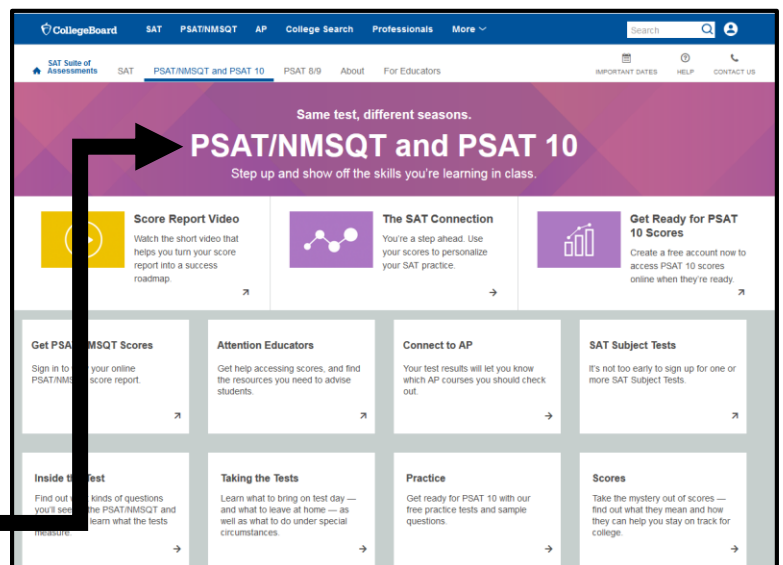
Part 1: College Board/PSAT Score Reports

- Using either Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox browser go to www.collegeboard.org
- On the left hand side of the College Board webpage click on **[Sign Up]**
 - If you have already created a College Board account enter your username and password
- Click **[I am a Student]**
- Create Your Student Account by **entering your information** for each of the required fields
 - **REMEMBER:** This is the SAME account you will eventually use to send your SAT and AP exam scores to colleges!
 - Enter an email address you use regularly and will remember
 - When creating your username and password write it down or save it somewhere safe
- **Check the box** to agree with the terms & conditions and click **[Next]**
- Confirm your information by **checking each of the boxes** and then click **[Confirm]**
- Verify your Password by **entering your Password again** and click **[Sign In]**
- This will take you to the Main Page of your College Board Account (<https://www.collegeboard.org/>)



Part 2: Adding Your PSAT Scores

- Under the PSAT/MNSQT column on the far right, click **[Explore the PSAT/NMSQT and PSAT 10]**
- On the next screen click on **[Add Scores]**
- Update your account by adding your mailing address then click **[Update]**
- At the bottom click **[Get My Scores]**
- In the Get Your Scores Matching Tool enter the following:
 - Click the button for **"I can supply my test information"**
 - Under Select A Test select **PSAT 10**
 - Admin Year: **2018**
 - PSAT Access Code: **found on the front of your PSAT score report**
 - Click **[Get My Scores]**
- This will take you to the PSAT/NMSQT and PSAT 10 screen for the SAT Suite of Assessments



Part 3: College Board Official SAT Test Prep: Khan Academy (www.khanacademy.org/sat)

- Scroll down to the bottom of the PSAT/NMSQT and PSAT 10 page of the SAT Suite of Assessment in your account
- Under CollegeBoard + KhanAcademy Click on **[Practice Now]** or **[SAT Practice on Khan Academy]**
- Click on **[Practice Now]** or **[Check it out now]**
- Enter your **Name, email, birthdate** and click **[Sign up]**
- Open and **login in to** the **email account** you entered
- Go into your Inbox and **open** the **email from Khan Academy** Accounts and click on **[Finish Signing Up]**
 - When creating your username and password use the following format (same as your College Board account):
- You will be asked "Which SAT do you want to practice for?" Select **C: PSAT/NMSQT (next October)**
- Enter your **zip code**
- Select **A: Sign in to CollegeBoard.org and send your PSAT results to Khan Academy**, then scroll down to click **[Onward]** at the bottom right of the screen
 - If you have not taken the PSAT, you can choose B Take your first diagnostic quiz
- On the next screen click **[Send]** to approve the request
- Wait while Khan Academy uploads and analyzes your results
- When this is completed you will be taken to the Khan Academy Dashboard
