Attention Maynard Jackson Juniors and Seniors!



Do you have any questions about dues and the prom? Here are a few answers:

- 1. What is the theme of the prom? The Juniors will decide January, 2019.
- 2. Do I have to pay my junior fees if I want to attend the prom? YES.
- 3. Do I have to pay my fees if I don't attend the prom? YES, please see the reverse side for more information.
- 4. Do I have to pay junior fees if I were never in a junior advisory? YES, students are still eligible to attend the prom because they are a part of the Junior/Senior Class Cohorts.
- 5. How much are the Junior and Senior Fees?
 - a. First Time Juniors/Seniors who did not pay Junior Fees--\$200 (Due Friday, March 22, 2019)
 - b. Senior Fees--\$275
- 6. I paid my money, when do I get my prom ticket?
 - a. All tickets will be administered April 12, 2019.
 - b. You will be given an allotted time to pick up your tickets.
- 7. Can I bring someone who is **NOT** a Maynard H. Jackson High School student? YES.
 - a. Date may not be over 21 years of age
 - b. Date must bring VALID photo identification to enter the prom.
 - c. You must purchase a \$50 ticket for your non-Maynard H. Jackson date to attend the prom.
- 8. I paid for my extra ticket, is that all I have to do? NO.
 - a. The prom guest application will be available for in January 22, 2019. All forms must be returned by March 22, 2019.
 - b. Your date must be administratively cleared to attend the prom.
 - c. If your date is not allowed to attend, your money will reimbursed.
- 9. Your attire must be appropriate; hence, only formal attire is allowed. Too short dresses and sagging pants are prohibited.
- 10. How do I run for prom royalty?
 - a. You must meet the following criteria:
 - i. Cumulative 2.5 GPA
 - ii. No disciplinary infractions for the year
 - iii. Good attendance (No more than three unexcused absences for the semester and four unexcused tardies)
 - b. Applications will be distributed during advisory in March.
- 11. Do the Junior dues only pay for the prom? The Junior dues pay for the following: two proms, two prom picture packages, parking for the prom venue for two years, and a t-shirt. If the Junior class pays in suggested installments on the following page, more activities can be planned.
- 12. All of the preceding information is about the prom, does this cover senior dues also? NO!

 Senior dues cover the following: cap/gown, diploma cover, yearbook, senior week activities, senior recognition, graduation stoles, senior t-shirt, Visions of the Future Ceremony, graduation programs, senior picnic, and senior breakfast.
- 13. If I don't pay my senior dues until prom do I get a discount because I didn't participate in any activities the seniors had? NO, you still owe the full amount

If you would like to be on a payment plan, you may follow the suggested payment schedule:

January 31, 2019: \$75

February 28, 2019: \$75

March 22, 2019: \$50

Students not wishing to attend the Junior Prom will receive a \$50 reduction in their senior fees the following year.

Students not wishing to attend the Senior Prom will receive a \$50 reduction in total fees (pay \$150).

Students not wishing to attend both the Junior and Senior Proms will receive a \$125 reduction in their senior fees.

Seniors, If you know for certain you are not going to prom only pay 200.00 and leave the remaining 75. It'll be credited after Prom.

Refunds will not be granted for class fees.
