## **School Strategies**

 Lack of consistent process for targeted students who are tardy and/or absent.

• Family dynamic issues (i.e. wrap around support, homelessness, challenges at home, etc.)

Transient Population

2a. Implement with fidelity a schoolwide attendance plan.
2b.Communication to parents after the 5<sup>th</sup> day of tardy (written communication, and referral to CARE team).

2c. Communication to parents after the 10<sup>th</sup> day of tardy (written communication, referral to CARE team, and face to face meeting with guardian).

2d. Communication to parents after the 15<sup>th</sup> day of tardy (written communication, referral to CARE team, face to face meeting with guardian, and intensive intervention strategies put in place).

2e. Frequently use the apsgraphs website to identify students who have missed 10 or more days of school.

2f. Frequently monitor students with high absenteeism.

2g. Attendance Incentives.
