

Entry Requirements

COVID-19 Protection

Guests are required to **wear a mask at all times** that covers the nose and mouth. **No exceptions.** Compliance with the facemask policy will contribute to the safety and comfort of everyone. Guests will be asked COVID-19 pre-screening questions before entry can be granted. **Access will be denied to any guest whose temperature measures greater than 100.4 degrees** and for guests who answer yes to any of the COVID-19 pre-screening questions. Persons with underlying medical conditions or are at a higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19 are strongly encouraged to stay home. Persons who have COVID-19 like symptoms must stay home and consult with a medical provider. Access will also be denied to persons who have been instructed to isolate due to a diagnosis of COVID-19 or quarantine due to exposure to a confirmed case of COVID-19.

Arm Band Entry

Guests attending the ceremonies must present an official **grad nation arm band** to gain entry. Upon arrival, guests should visit their school's table located conveniently in the front of Lakewood Stadiums visitor's side to receive an arm band. As a reminder, four arm bands will be distributed per graduate.

Clear Bag Policy

A clear bag policy will be enforced. Clear bags should be no larger than 12" X 6" X 12". Small clutch purses should be no larger than 4.5" X 6.5". One-gallon clear plastic storage bags will also be permitted. An exception will be made for medical bags and diaper bags after a proper inspection by a gate attendant. A bag check-in station **will not** be available for guests who do not comply to the clear bag policy.

Prohibited Items

For safety reasons, the following items are not permitted into Lakewood Stadium:

Outside food and drinks, Weapons (including those carried with a permit), Illegal Drugs, Alcohol Beverages, Tents, Balloons, Noise Makers, Lawn Chairs, Stadium Seats, Blankets, Flags and banners, Selfie Sticks, Laser Pointers, Coolers, Cans, Personal transportation devices (skateboards, hover boards, scooters, bicycles etc.) and Pets.

Stadium Safety

Guest seats will be seated six feet apart to ensure safety. Families are encouraged to arrive together in order to receive seating as a family group.

Hand sanitizing stations will be available throughout the stadium. Additionally, common touch points including the restrooms, railings and door handles will be sanitized routinely.

A care tent will be available for persons who experience COVID-19 symptoms while attending the ceremony.

Parking

Attendees will enter through Lakewood Stadium's **visitor's** side. We encourage guests to **arrive one hour** in advance of their respective ceremonies. Parking is available on the visitor's side and at the Cellairis Amphitheatre at Lakewood. Due to health and safety concerns, a shuttle service **will not** be provided. Guests should wear comfortable shoes for walking and weather appropriate attire.
