III. Discussion Items

a. **2023 Spring MAPS results**

We discussed and compared the Spring results to the Winter results in both reading and math. The winter data showed half of each grade meeting their

goal, whereas the Spring data showed a significant decrease. Possible causes for the decrease are teachers did not monitor their own students, and 43 new students enrolled from winter to spring. The 2nd and 5th grades showed an increase in reading.

b. **BASC-3 results:** Survey for teachers and students based on anxiety and behavior. Teachers had to answer questions on each child, and students rated themselves. Looked at survey data from Fall2022 and Spring 2023. From the results the CARE team form groups on what students' needs (visiting school-based therapist, and rap-around services.)

c. **Needs Assessment**

We looked at data from the Spring MAPS administration and identified 2-3 potential needs for the 2023-2024 school year. This discussion will help begin the development of the school's 2023-2024 Continuous Improvement Plan this summer. The three needs identified are:

- 1 Teachers releasing students to independent practice.
- 2 Ensuring we allow productive struggle.
- 3 New student protocol for gaps and gaining data from previous school.
