

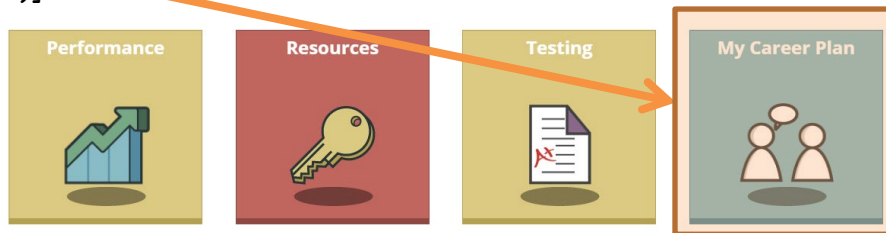

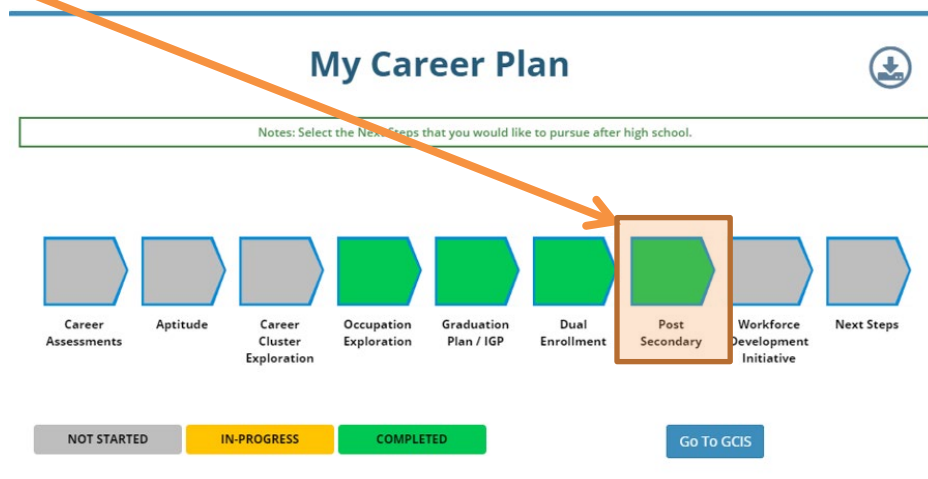

How Do I Complete My BRIDGE Advisement Checklist Activity in GCIS?

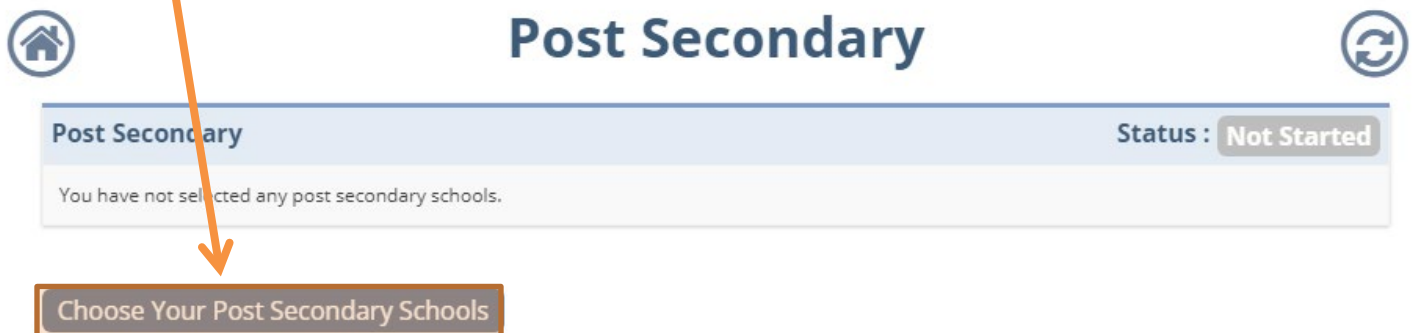
1. Log into your student portal provided by your school district.

4. Click **Postsecondary** to explore and save at least 3 postsecondary options that match your plans for life after high school.

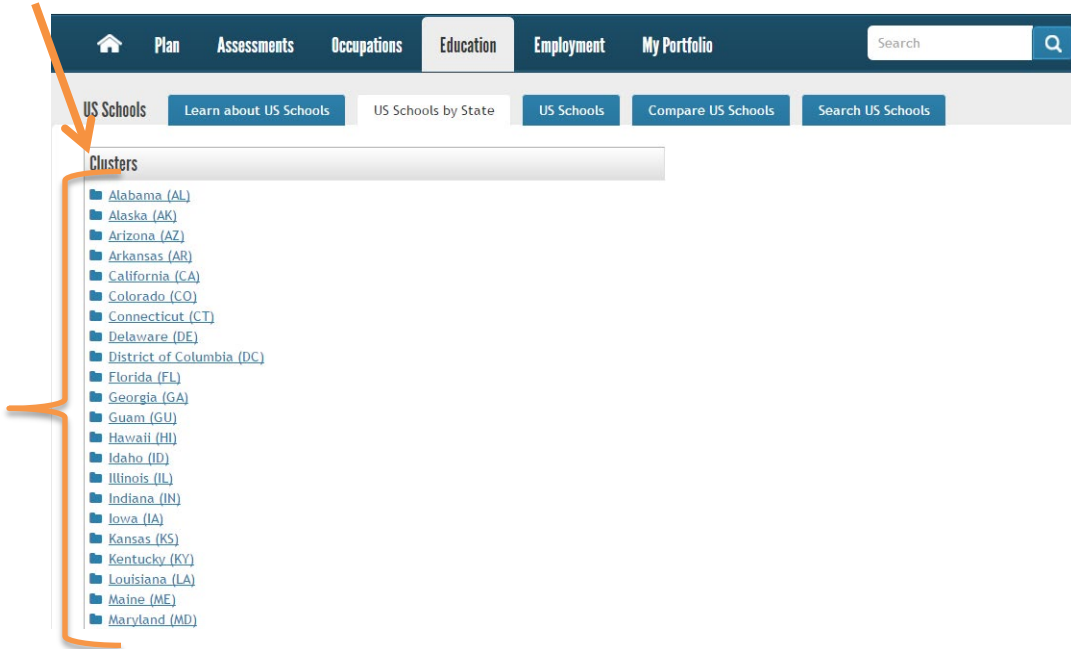


5. Click **Choose Your Postsecondary Schools**.

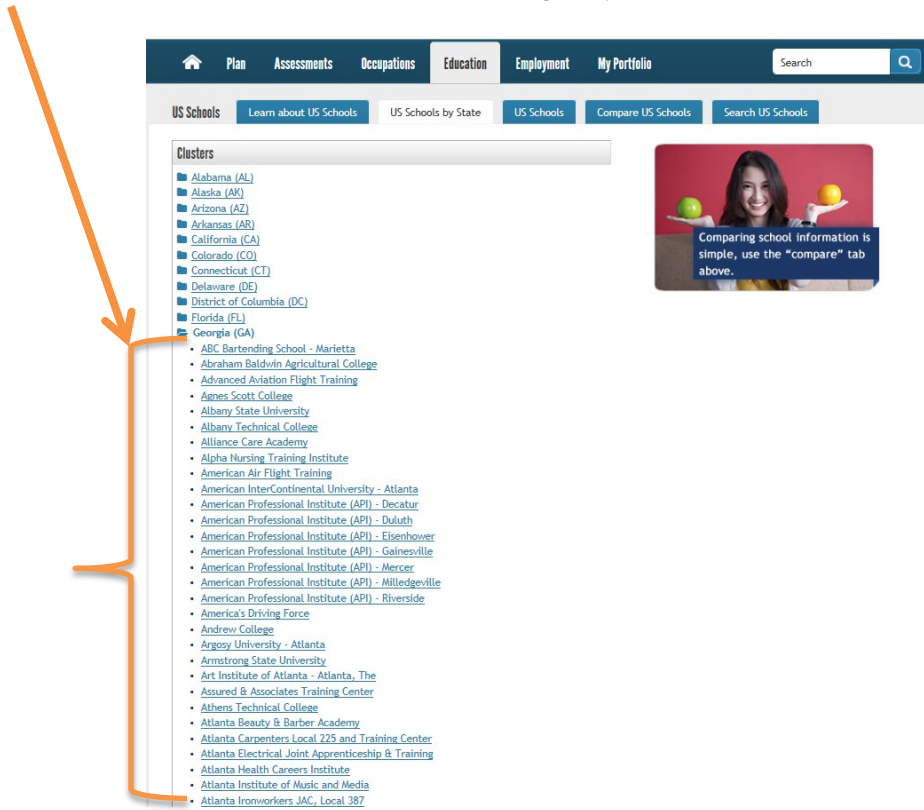

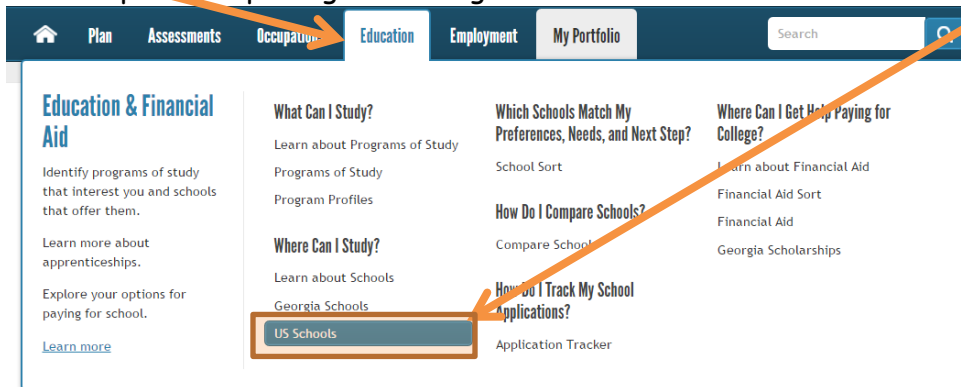
