- 1. Reviewed Go Team budget process
- 2. Reviewed strategic plan and goals of the school and district's vision and mission
- 3. Reviewed 9 priorities for FY22 budget parameters and rationales
- 4. Discussed FY22 allotments
- 5. \$6,411,037 allocations for FY22 \$6,410,606 budgeted for with \$85,000 in reserve
- 6. Majority of the budget is spent on people and positions the only portion not spent on people is the \$85,000 in reserves
- 7. The vote on the reserve amount is a separate vote
- 8. Plan to use reserves for "pay back" for any leveling due to under enrollment
- 9. If do not need reserve money for "pay back" then can put it towards other items
- 10. Plan to also use reserves for instructional staff and instructional supplies and materials
- 11. \$50,000 that was not spent this year will fund textbooks for next year
- 12. Reviewed key proposals in FY22 budget
- 13. Improving teacher capacity in literacy and math is a priority
- 14. Since we have prioritized law class sizes, we have some of the lowest class sizes in the North Atlanta cluster

- 15. We have not had a parent liaison position for several months so these responsibilities have been spread among other areas
- 16. E. Rivers' portion of the CARES allotment is \$215,050 which we will use for school-wide intervention \$107,100 for hourly teacher tutors;
 \$99,517 for SST Intervention Specialist; \$8,433 instructional resources
- 17. Teachers really like High Touch High Tech opportunities so will look into possibly doing more of these
- 18. We will plan to make a sub-committee to explore additional opportunities to ask EREF if they would consider funding

- Surveillance testing updates have not produced any positive results to date – testing done every Tuesday
- 2. Teachers are being very diligent about making sure students social distance and keep their masks on
- 3. 2/3 of students will return in-person on March 22nd we do not anticipate having to use hybrid model for the remainder of the year since we are able to fit up to 18 students six feet apart in a classroom and the two classes that can not fit their students six feet apart will move to overflow classrooms to allow social distancing
- 4. APS may still offer a virtual option in the fall
