- iv. Growth goal is 70% or more of classroom meeting growth target.
- v. Kindergarteners started at the 77th percentile; want them at 50% or higher. 85th percentile average in the spring. (Reading)
- vi. First grade high achievement, but lower growth (Reading)
- vii. 2nd grade moved from average to high average in achievement. (Reading)
- viii. Highlighting Ms. Pearson who took over a 5th grade classroom in the fall. 100% of the students in her class met their growth target.

- ii. 90% to 88% at normal risk puts us above district average
