PRINCIPAL'S WELCOME - Sharyn Briscoe

Kids and staff are getting into a good groove with F2F return, but as we enter the final quarter, more kids will be back and we will need to adjust again and that looks like a true hybrid model to accommodate the social distancing requirements.

Working on Hybrid modeling – M/T groups, W asynchronous, TH/F groups

70% of Mary Lin students plan on returning back to school – only 3 schools in APS have a higher percentage. (Brandon, Jackson, Smith – each have 2 campuses), Morningside and Spark are leaning towards hybrid model as well.

New schedule by March 12^{th} is the goal – Thursday noon lunch and learn

Rising Kindergarten lunch and learn was last week – well attended

We are in the home stretch and it will be disruptive to some families but we need to pivot to get as many kids back as possible.

They are looking at some outdoor options but they won't be able to hold actual classes out there due to tech challenges. Outside for whole day can't work. Too many hurdles.
