What is Title 1?

What is it?

How is it revised?

Deerwood Academy invited all parents to attend our Annual School Forum last spring to review and revise this parental involvement policy, as well as the School-wide Plan, our School-Parent Compact, and the Parental Involvement Budget. Additionally, parent input and comments regarding this plan are welcome during the school year through an online form. The plan is posted on our school website for parents to view and submit feedback throughout the year. Who is it for?

All students participating in the Title I, Part A Program, and their families are encouraged and invited to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. Deerwood Academy will provide full opportunity for the participation of Parents with limited English, Parents with disabilities, and Parents of migratory children.

Where is it available?

At the beginning of the year, the plan is included in the student handbook that is given to all students. As a reminder, we will mail the plan to all parents in August before the scheduled Open House event. Also, the plan will be posted on the school's website. Deerwood Academy Goals

The percentage of students in grades K-5 that meet their Fall to Spring growth goal on MAP Reading will increase from 57% to 60% in May 2025.

The percentage of students in grades 3-5 scoring proficient or above on the spring 2025 GMAS English Language Arts Assessment will increase from 25% to 29%

The percentage of students in grades K-5 that meet their Fall to Spring growth goal on MAP Mathematics will increase from 49% to 52% in May 2025.

The percentage of students in grades 3-5 scoring proficient or above on the spring 2025 GMAS Math Assessment will increase from 20% to 23%.
