Student Attendance and Punctuality to Class





- All students must attend school daily.
 Attendance impacts grades.
- Make it a priority to get to every class everyday on time. Classes begin at 8:45 and end at 3:45. Two-min. warning bell each period.
- Tardy Sweeps occur each period. If students are not seated by the bell, they must have a pass to enter class.
- Students arriving late to school must receive a tardy pass. Out zone students are subject to withdrawal.

Backpack Policy

BACKPACK POLICY

- Students are permitted to bring either a **CLEAR or SEE-THROUGH MESH BACKPACK**. Backpacks that are not clear or mesh will not be permitted and will be collected at the entrance. Students are permitted a small purse for personal items, however, be advised that bags large enough to hold a textbook or binder are considered book bags.
- · For student-athletes and band members, we collaborate with your coaches/sponsors to ensure equipment bags are stored appropriately throughout the day until afterschool.







Beginning Monday, August 16th, parents will be responsible for picking up bookbags. We will not re-distribute bags to students at
