ABOUT THE FELLOWSHIP

The Knowledge House is seeking high school youth interested in learning code and design skills! The Karim Kharbouch Coding Fellowship (KKCF) was co-founded by Hip Hop Artist French Montana and supports youth interested in STEM.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

The fellowship is a 12-month program, starting with paid, virtual summer training, followed by monthly career & college access workshops and coaching. Graduates are then supported with obtaining internships and gaining access to college STEM programs.

Inaugural KKCF alumni have gone on to STEM programs at top colleges like Wellesley & Carnegie Mellon, and advanced coding programs by Google.

TO BE CONSIDERED FOR ADMISSION, APPLICANTS MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING QUALIFICATIONS:

- A New York State, Newark, Atlanta, or Los Angeles Resident
- 16-21 years old
- Currently enrolled as sophomores through seniors in your local high school
- Proficient in written and spoken English
- Available for the duration of the program

Phase II: Workshops and Check-ins	<p>Monthly check-ins and workshops will be held to assist with college and career readiness, as well as build upon tech skills learned in the class.</p> <p>Dates: September through May 2023 Days and Times: Weekday evenings and/or Weekends</p> <p>Location: Virtually</p>
Phase III: College, Internship or Fellowship Opportunity	<p>After completing the program, fellows are encouraged to seek opportunities that include (not limited to) college, internships or another fellowship. The talent and placement team at TKH will assist with this process.</p> <p>Dates: After July 1, 2023 Days and Times: Varies depending on the opportunity</p> <p>Location: In-person and/or Virtually</p>

STIPEND INFORMATION

- Stipends will be distributed through an electronic gift card.
- Stipends are based on attendance. Attendance will be tracked daily to determine the stipend amount.
- The total stipend amount is \$1000.
 - First 3 weeks paid out up to \$500
 - Second 3 weeks paid out up to \$500
- Absences and latenesses are deducted from the stipend.
 - \$40 for each absence
 - \$20 for each lateness
- Fellows must notify instructors in advance to avoid deductions.

PRE-SCREENING

The TKH application can be found on our website. Anyone interested in our programs should fill out the application which will consist of questions about your demographics and your interest in the program.



PRE-ASSESSMENT

The pre-assessment is automatically emailed to all eligible applicants who have successfully completed our application. It is used to gauge your computational and divergent thinking. It consists of 4 multiple choice questions and 2 short answer questions. This assessment should take no more than 20-30 minutes to complete.



INTERVIEW

The Interview set up link will automatically be emailed to applicants who have successfully passed the Pre-Assessment.

During this interview, applicants will get the opportunity to share more about who they are, what their experiences and goals are for the program. TKH staff will also view applicants supporting documents during the interview. The interview can take up to 45 minutes for the KKCF program.
