




Microsoft and STEM Women of Atlanta Visit EC

Microsoft and STEM Women of Atlanta engaged EC seniors in an Al challenge and a Q&A to educate students on STEM careers.




Hands-On Learning

Students in Ms. Harding's math class draw real life examples of quadratic functions, such as throwing a football and firing a missile.




EC Recognized for Achievement in Literacy


