

Dear VHE Parents & Guardians,

Want to volunteer at VHE? In order to be fully-vetted as a volunteer (i.e., to volunteer in the classroom or attend field trips), you need to have a Level 3 Clearance Certificate, issued by the APS Office of Safety and Security (APS OSS). To become a Level 3 Volunteer, you have to get a background check. If you are interested in getting your Level 3 volunteer clearance, please complete the VHE Volunteer Interest Form and someone will be in touch with to schedule your appointment with the APS OSS. After you've filled out our form and have received your appointment time, and prior to your background check, you'll need to do the following:

- Complete the APS Background Check Consent Form
- Complete the VHE Volunteer Release Form
- Pay the \$45 background check fee using a debit/credit card via this link: <u>Safety & Security</u>
 MySchoolBucks Payment System
- Make a Fingerprinting Appointment using the APS Safety & Security Calendly Link (Don't make your appointment until you hear from a VHE staff member. We must submit a volunteer application on your behalf before you go!)
- Make sure to bring an **unexpired** form of identification that contains a photo (i.e. driver's license, state issued identification card, Permanent Resident Card, or a US Passport) to your appointment.

APS OSS is located inside of the parking garage in the basement level of the Atlanta Public Schools Center for Leadership & Learning (CLL).
