

To our continuing scholars, WELCOME BACK to the 2024/25 school year at Coretta Scott King Young Women's Leadership Academy. To our new parents and scholars, we are excited about your decision to become an official member of the CSK family! We are elated and highly anticipating what we know will be a phenomenal school year. Each year we strive to provide a true "private school experience in our public school setting." Although we are growing in numbers, we have worked to maintain small class sizes 18:1 in our core content classes.

Our goal for the upcoming school year is to continue in our strides to improve academic outcomes by embracing rigor, remediation, and enrichment through direct and explicit instruction. In making this goal a reality, we will proceed Full STEAM Ahead in our efforts to create empowering academic experiences and exposure that champions status quo. This year, we will expand our world language offerings with the inclusion of ASL (American Sign Language) ACT/SAT prep classes, and Intro to Engineering for middle and high school scholars. As an Early College/STEAM Signature/pathway school, each child will be able to follow a program of study that results in optimal academic performance and preparation for high school, college, and career.

STUDENT DAILY EXPECTATIONS

- 1. Students are expected to arrive to school between 8:00 a.m. and 8:15 a.m. in order to report to their first class by 8:30 a.m.
- 2. Students should report to each class on time. Attendance will be taken during the first 15 minutes of each class to denote whether students are present, absent, or tardy. All students are expected to maintain an Average Daily Attendance of >90%. Parents of students with more than 3 unexcused absences will be required to meet with the Whole Child Intervention team to address attendance concerns.
- 3. Students should come dressed according to the CSK dress code. (Khaki, chocolate brown, or pink pants with pink, white or brown collared shirts. All hoodies should also be pink, brown or white (no hair bonnets, hair scarves, or bandanas etc.)
- 4. Students should come prepared daily with the school supplies needed to complete all learning tasks (fully charged laptops, chargers, paper, pencil, notebook etc.)
- Laptops will be issued to all students. * Continuing students must return their 23/24 assigned laptop before being issued a new device.
- 6. Students are expected to attend tutorial sessions for additional support in any classes with missing assignments or failing grades.

CSKYWLA Uniform Dress Code



- O All scholars must wear the approved uniform skirt or pant. The length of the skirt is to be no more than 1" above the knee in front and back. Skirts may not be rolled.
- O All girls are expected to wear the approved school collared shirts without logos or writing. These may be short or long-sleeved, clean and pressed. Blouses/shirts are to be completely tucked in at all times.
- o Chocolate brown knee socks or tights are to be worn with the uniform skirt.
- O Shoes with the uniform should have a low heel, be conservative in style and solid black or solid brown in color. Sneakers may be worn; solid color only black/brown/pink/ or white. The following shoes may NOT be worn: backless or open-toed shoes, clogs, platform shoes or shoes with ankle straps, slippers, or sandals.
- All clothing should fit and be worn properly. Oversized, droopy clothing, extremely tight fitting, low overly revealing clothing are not acceptable forms of attire.
- Extremes in haircuts, hairstyles, or hair color are not permitted. Excessive make-up is inappropriate. Bandanas and head-scarves are never permitted while in uniform - on or off campus.
- *Earrings no bigger than a quarter may be worn. Tongue rings, nose rings or visible pierced body parts are not acceptable and may not be worn. Visible tattoos are not permitted.
