Usher-Collier ES and our parents have adopted the APTT model as the school's communication for engaging parents, students, and the community.

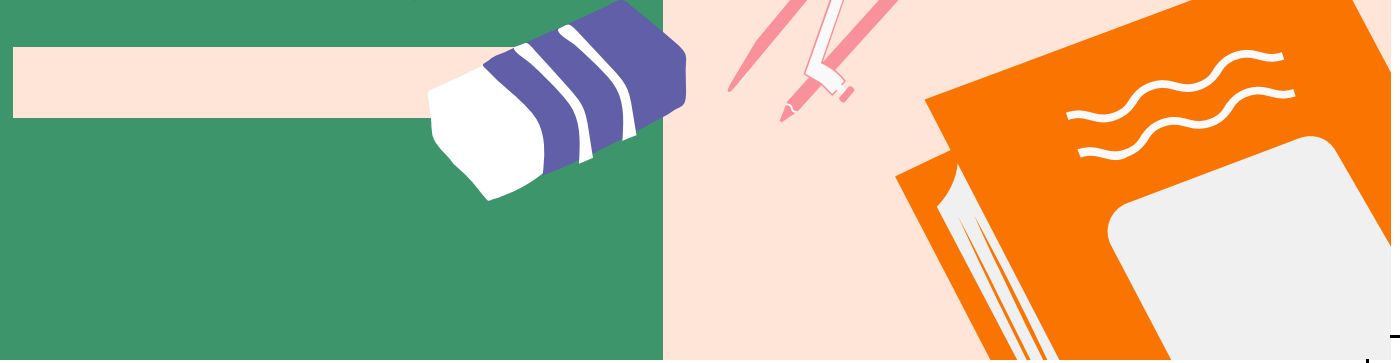

We will:
