



## Community Vaccine Clinic Info for Host Sites

Thank you for your participation in helping to offer vaccines to families in need on Atlanta's West Side.

The following vaccines will be offered to children and teens ages four & up according to the CDC recommended vaccine schedule:

Vaccine	Typical Age Given
d-tap + polio	4
MMR	4
Varicella	4
t-dap	11 – 12
Meningococcal	11 – 12
MENB	16 – 17

Clinic staffing includes Children's Healthcare of Atlanta employees, as well as volunteers from Morehouse School of Medicine, Georgia Early Education Alliance for Ready Students, and Chris 180. Number of staff and volunteers will remain at a minimum to accommodate social distancing.

We will screen all participants and family members using temperature checks. We will promote drive-up service (when appropriate) until the patient needs to board the Ronald McDonald Care Mobile® for his vaccine(s). All participants and family members accompanying them on the Care Mobile will receive a mask to wear at all times. Staff and volunteers will also implement enhanced cleaning precautions.

Chris 180 will have a Community Health Worker present to offer additional resources and guidance to families in need. GEEARs will offer books from the Mayor's Summer Reading Club 2020 book selections. All giveaways will be available while supplies last.
