Atlanta Public Schools Kindergarten Round-Up is an orientation program for rising kindergarteners and their parents. It's an opportunity for parents to register their child for kindergarten and take the first step towards a smoother transition to kindergarten for both child and family.

Parents are asked to bring the following information to Kindergarten Round-Up:

- Student's birth certificate
- Student's social security card
- Proof of residency
- Photo ID
- Immunization record (GA Form 3231)
- Ear, eye, and dental records (GA Form 3300)

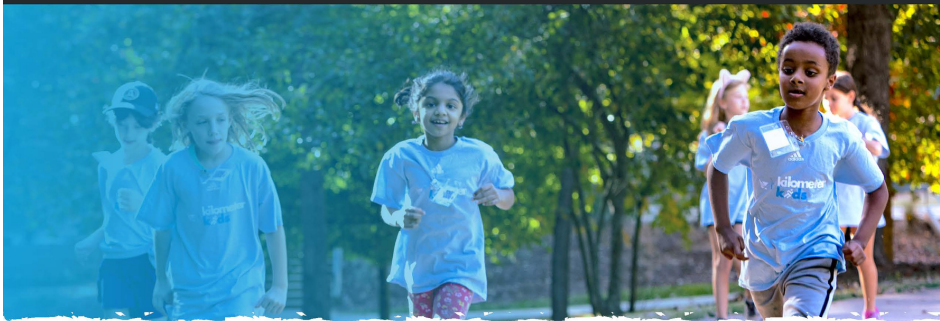

Looking for an afterschool program to help your child get more physically active through running?

Check out Atlanta Track Club's Kilometer Kids program being offered at your school or in your community! There is no fee to participate, and the program is for all elementary students regardless of running ability or experience. As a noncompetitive program, being a Kilometer Kid is not about running the fastest or winning the race.
