Morning Arrival and Transportation

- Arrival: Scholars can enter the school from 7:15 AM. Classes begin promptly at 7:45 AM.
- Carpool Location: Please use the bottom lot for carpool drop-off and pick-up.
- Buses: Bus schedules will be provided at the Open House and are available on the school website.
- Parent Park/Walk: Parents who park and walk their children to the building should do so in designated areas for safety. (Fairburn Road near Jackson Memorial Church)
- Tardy Time and Process: Students arriving after 7:45 AM are considered tardy, and they must be escorted into the building by a parent/guardian and signed in for school.
