CEP PROGRAM

59 schools will participate in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP Program), which offers **FREE** breakfast and lunch for **ALL** students enrolled.

FEA PROGRAM



12 schools will participate in the Federal Eligibility Application (FEA Program), which offers **free or reduced-priced meals** to **qualifying students**.

Students enrolled in **FEA schools MUST apply to qualify for free or reduced-priced meals** by completing the online FEA form.



NO COMPUTER?

Complete the FEA application from your cell phone or contact your child's school!

Paper applications can be picked up at your child's school starting **July 26th** from their school's FEA coordinator.

Paper Applications take 10 days to process, which is longer than an online application.

Families paying for meals must submit payment through the **MySchoolBucks.com** online payment system. Schools will not be collecting money for school meals.
