★ CEP PROGRAM

59 schools will participate in the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP Program), which offers FREE breakfast and lunch for ALL students enrolled.

FEA PROGRAM



12 schools will participate in the Federal Eligibility Application (FEA Program), which offers free or reduced-priced meals to qualifying students.

Students enrolled in FEA schools MUST apply to qualify for free or reduced-priced meals by completing the online FEA form.

NO COMPUTER?

Complete the FEA application from your cell phone or contact your child's school!

Paper applications can be picked up at your child's school starting July 26th from their school's FEA coordinator.

Paper Applications take 10 days to process, which is longer than an online application.

* The Georgia State Board of Education has voted to cover the cost of reduced-price meals for any student approved for reduced-price meals for the 2024-2025 school year. Therefore, the student will not be charged for these meals

<u>Families paying for meals must submit payment through the MySchoolBucks.com online</u> payment system. Schools will not be collecting money for school meals.
